

Valletta

Malta's capital, Valletta, enchants with its golden-stone streets, majestic Grand Harbour views, and cultural landmarks like St. John's Co-Cathedral. A UNESCO-listed treasure, this Baroque city blends historical splendour with lively cafés, offering a captivating journey through Malta's past and present.

Three Cities

Across Valletta's Grand Harbour, the Three Cities—Birgu, Senglea, and Cospicua—offer an authentic glimpse into Malta's maritime history. These fortified towns charm with winding streets, vibrant waterfronts, and historic sites, including remnants of ancient civilizations.

St Julian's

Day 1 Valletta

Welcome to historic Valletta, a UNESCO World Heritage Listed City and Europe's most southern capital. Transfer to your hotel and enjoy the evening at leisure.

STAY 4 NIGHTS: The Gomerino Hotel

Day 2 Valletta (B)

Embark on a half day private guided tour of Valletta, Malta's capital built by the Knights of the Order of St. John. Visit the Barracca Gardens with a breath-taking panorama of the Grand Harbour and tour the magnificent St. John's Co-Cathedral and the Grand Master Palace. The afternoon is yours to enjoy at leisure.

Day 3 Valletta – Three Cities – Valletta (B)

Discover Malta's 'Three Cities'— Vittoriosa, Cospicua, and Senglea— where the Knights of St. John settled in 1530. Take a private walking tour through Vittoriosa's narrow streets, then

enjoy a typical dghajsa boat cruise across the Grand Harbour to Valletta Marina. Have time for an independent lunch at a harbourside restaurant before a short stroll back to central Valletta for an afternoon at leisure.

Day 4 Valletta – Gozo – Valletta (B, L)

Embark on a full day excursion to Gozo, the island of the nymph Calypso. Visit Ggantija prehistoric temples as well as Victoria and its Citadel before a delicious 3-course lunch with wine at a local restaurant. You may opt to upgrade your return on a private boat to circle the Island of Comino and view the Blue Lagoon and Crystal Lagoon.

Day 5 Valletta – Ancient Malta – Marsaxlokk – Mдина (B)

Enjoy a full-day private tour with guide and driver exploring Malta's ancient history. Visit top sites including Hagar Qim, the main prehistoric site, and the Hypogeum, an underground chamber

over 6,000 years old. Continue to the Blue Grotto for an optional boat trip through sea caves (weather permitting), then visit the ancient fishing village of Marsaxlokk before checking into your Mдина hotel.

STAY 2 NIGHTS: The Xara Palace Relais & Chateaux 5-star or similar

Day 6 Mдина (B, L)

Enjoy a half day guided tour of Malta's medieval city of Mдина, the former capital, including the Cathedral and St. Paul's Catacombs. Narrow, winding streets from the Arab period lead to imposing bastions with panoramic island views. Afterwards, enjoy a gastronomic journey at one of Malta's traditional restaurants.

Day 7 Mдина (B)

After breakfast, stay for additional leisure time or transfer to the airport for your ongoing journey.
